



The Mobile Airport Authority is an independent agency created in 1982 by the City of Mobile to own and operate the Mobile Regional Airport, Mobile Downtown Airport and Brookley Aeroplex.



The Brookley Aeroplex, a 1,700 acre industrial complex, is an outstanding multi-modal facility with immediate access to air, ground, rail, and water transportation. It is served by Interstate 10, which links the Atlantic Ocean to the Pacific, Interstate 65, which ties the Gulf of Mexico to Chicago, and provides access to five Class 1 railroads. With more than 65 different companies employing 3,700 people, the Brookley Aeroplex represents a significant portion of the Mobile Airport Authority's success.

Located on the Brookley Aeroplex, the Downtown Airport is a center of activity for general aviation and cargo air traffic on the Gulf Coast. The airport is fully-operational with a 9600 ft. main runway and 8600 ft. secondary runway; contract tower; ILS and AARF capability. As a freight-only facility, the multi-modal complex offers outstanding access to air, ground, rail and water transportation through the deep water Port of Mobile, Interstates 10 and 65, and CSX railroad.
