Leadership qualities and working experience in a culturally diverse environment are also desirable characteristics of our candidates.

About ICT

A new single organisation worldwide within the Airbus environment put in place April 2009, to support the standardisation of processes, drawing on best practices, ICT is recognised as the Information Systems (IS) partner to the Airbus business, sharing common targets and goals, providing an in-depth knowledge of the Airbus business combined with IS-expertise.

Our Mission is to:

- Provide robust and efficient IS Services.
- Guide Airbus in optimising and aligning its business processes in order to address current and future challenges, enabling Airbus to be more efficient.
- Translate Business Processes into an effective IS Solution.
- Drive standardisation and re-use through a harmonised and unique sustainable Enterprise Architecture.
- Enable innovation through effective use of State of the Art IS Technologies.

To achieve this the ICT organisation is divided into 7 units:

Governance - A framework that ensures that all domains bring maximum value for Airbus, through implementing a common ICT strategy and alignment.

Worldwide services (WWS) – Co-ordinate and facilitate the integration of WWS and partners, including 'remote sites and offshore centers' through effective ICT solutions.

Develop – Supporting and improving the Airbus Development process.

Fulfill and source – Supporting high performance business capabilities, improving manufacturing, logistic, quality, procurement and shop floor processes, for an integrated ARP and supply chain model.

Sell and support – Supporting and improving Airbus sales/after-sales capabilities to optimise internal processes and develop new business services.

Manage and enable and common solutions – provided and supported by 'Manage and Enable' to all other process domains for efficiency reasons and to increase standardisation.

Infrastructure - Developing and operating a secure, robust and harmonised infrastructure, enabling ICT domains to deliver common tools across the Airbus business. In parallel, leveraging the Airbus experience to accelerate the integration of EADS ICT backbone architecture.
