Mathilde Royer-Germain was appointed Digital Transformation Officer & Head of Company Transformation and a member of the Airbus Helicopters Executive Committee as of September 1st, 2019. Her role includes overseeing Information Management and Organization Management.

Prior to assuming this position, she led the optimization of the global Airbus Helicopters set-up since October 2018.
