

ODILE JUBECOURT **Head of A330neo Development**

Odile Jubécourt was appointed Head of A330neo Development in July 2014, thus becoming the first woman at Airbus to lead a major aircraft development programme, where she is in charge of more than 1,800 people and a budget of nearly €2 billion. Before that she had been in charge of several A330 derivatives (regional, military, cargo, 242t, etc.).

Odile Jubécourt began her career at Airbus in 1989 as a sales engineer providing avionics system support, before managing the creation of industrial partnerships and the development of new services for airlines in 1994. Then she moved on to production where she led several operational configuration management teams, quickly managing to implement a new and more efficient organisation in 2004, before taking responsibility for all the European teams in 2010.



Odile Jubécourt has an MBA in management from Northern Illinois University (USA) and an engineering degree from ENSEEIHT Toulouse. She is also a sponsor for several associations (Elles Bougent, Capital Filles) encouraging more young women to turn to scientific careers in order to promote the diversity of talents in businesses and training courses.
