With almost two decades of experience in helicopter engineering, Stefan Thomé assumed the role of Executive Vice President, Engineering, as well as Chief Technical Officer, at Airbus' helicopter division in April 2019.

Prior to assuming this role, Thomé led new digital business models & services at Airbus Defence & Space starting in 2018.

From 2013 to 2018, he worked as Head of Vehicle Integration & Doors Engineering, leading and managing all associated activities across Airbus Helicopters, while contributing to the definition of the Division's research and innovation policy. Before that, he held multiple management positions at Airbus Helicopters, mostly related to engineering and industry.
