

Klaus ROEWE

Senior Vice President, Head of Airbus Customer Services

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Klaus Roewe is Head of Customer Services at Airbus since 1st July, 2019. He is responsible for all Airbus support and services activities for airline customers, lessors and MROs, ranging from maintenance and upgrades to training and flight operations as well as material management and logistical support. Klaus Roewe reports to Philippe Mhun, Airbus Executive Vice-President Programmes & Services.

From March 2015 until the end of June 2019, Mr. Roewe was in charge of the single-aisle A320 Family programme, managing the A320 Family's profitability, production and product development. Prior to this, he had been responsible for the A320neo Family for four years.

From 2008 to 2010, Klaus Roewe was Senior Vice President Cabin & Cargo, responsible for the Interiors of all Airbus aircraft, ranging from A318 to A380.

From 2003 to 2008, he worked in the A320 Family Programme in various management positions in Programme Management and in the Final Assembly Line.

In 2000 he was nominated Senior Manager for Airbus' Manufacturing Strategy and International Cooperation with activities covering all Airbus sites and the world-wide supply chain.

From 1992 to 2000, Klaus Roewe held several positions in composites production and in A320 Family chief engineering.

During eight years as an officer in the German Federal Armed Forces, Mr. Roewe completed academic studies in mechanical engineering and joined Airbus in 1992 at the Stade plant.

Mr. Roewe was born in 1964 in Nordhorn, Germany. Married with two sons, he is a keen football supporter and an enthusiast of traditional vintage cars.
