Eurofighter availability boosted by collaboration

- GAF Eurofighter fleet availability >70% supported by strong Air Force / industry collaboration
- Resilient supply chain shows 50% less aircraft on ground due to missing parts (compared to 2019)
- Stable and high fleet utilization and strong service provision despite COVID: actuals in 2021 above target



Airbus as a trusted partner

- Long term contracts renewed until 2026
- Performance based logistic services by Airbus and its industry partners as enabler for GAF
- Eurofighter secures highly qualified jobs and technology at Airbus in Germany and the European supply chain

Eurofighter A most capable platform

- Eurofighter backbone of European Air Defence
- Most capable Air-to-Air platform
- Eurofighter provides already substantial Air-to-Surface capabilities
- Quadriga standard together with existing and agreed capability enhancements will provide further Air-to-Surface capabilities to take over new operational roles in the GAF

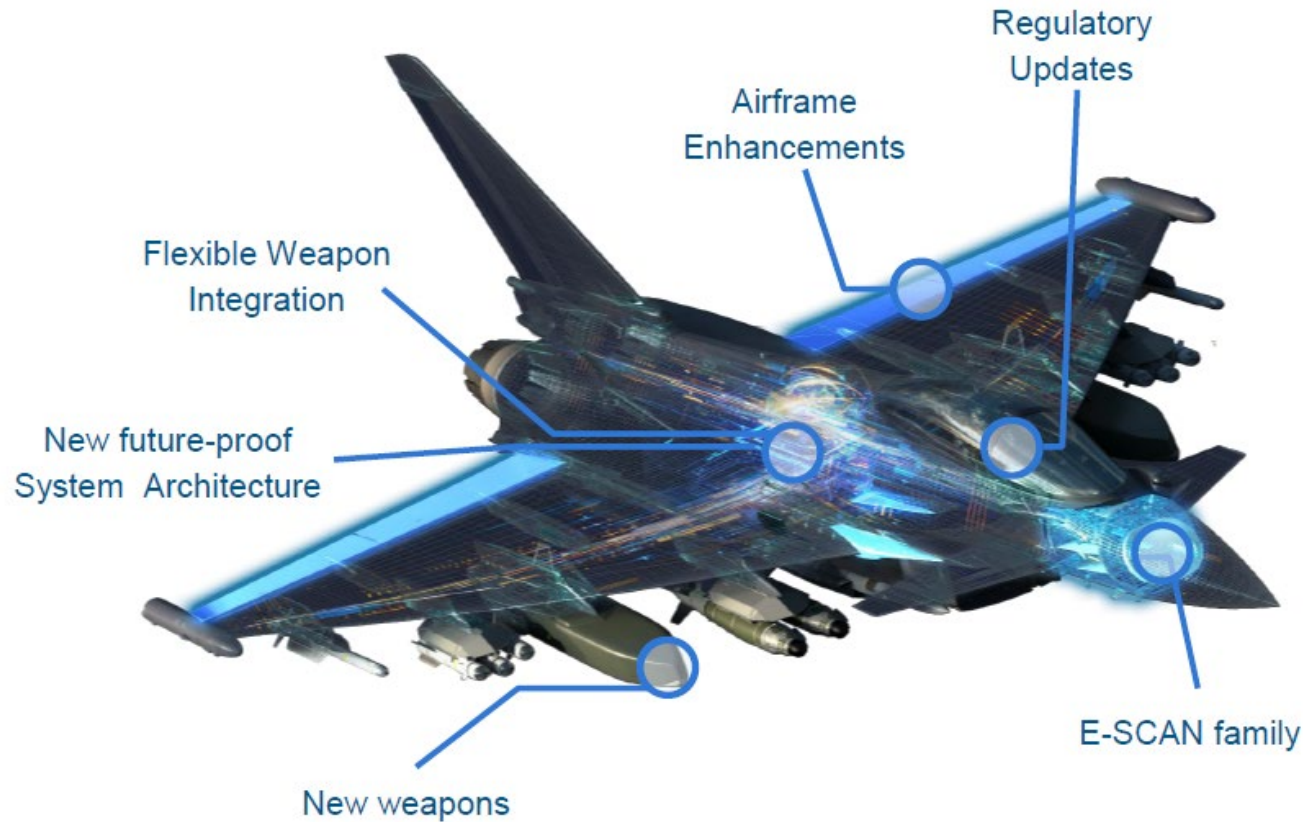


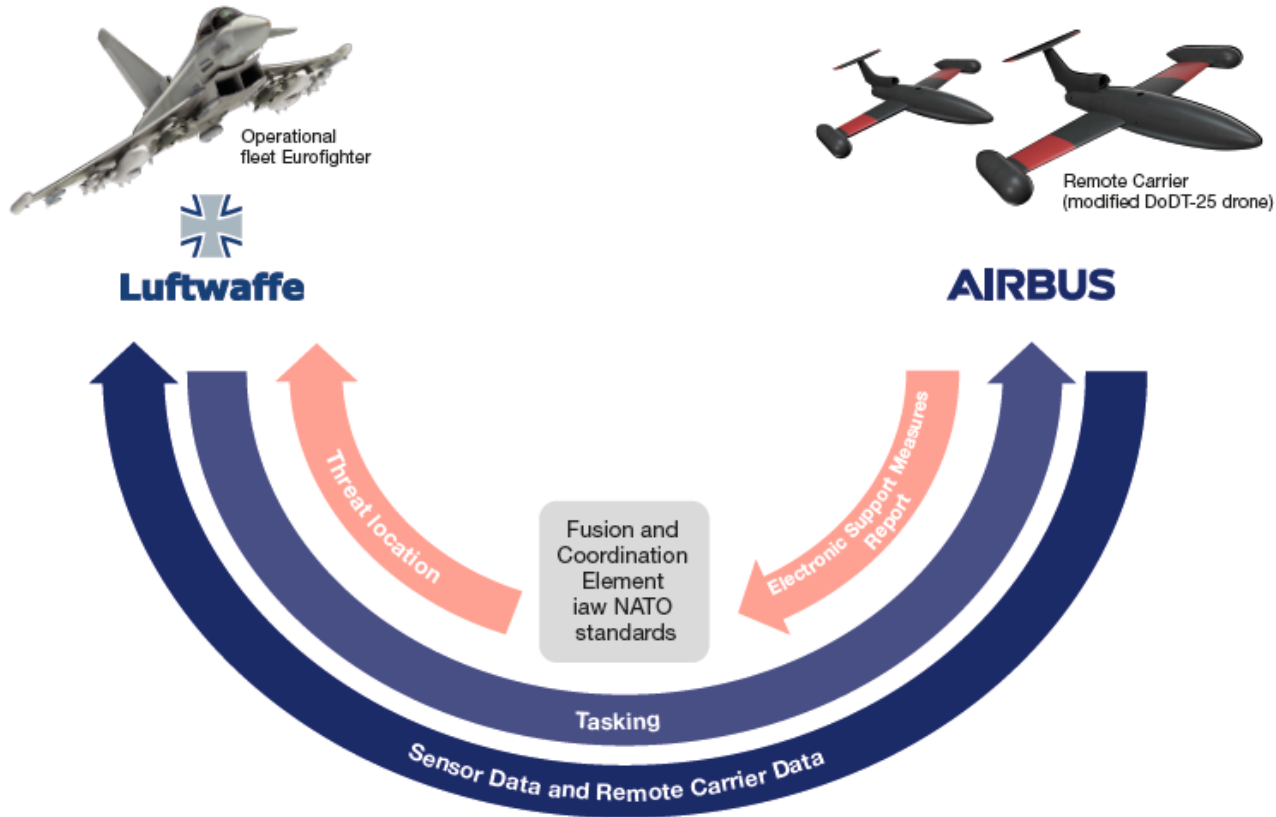
Eurofighter as the logical choice for Spain

- Eurofighter is the logical choice for replacement of obsolete F-18A's from Canary Island's Fighter Wing ('Halcon')
- Spain will benefit from economies of scale due to the synergies with the existing Eurofighter fleet
- Halcon will boost the national aerospace industries and maximize the return on investment

Eurofighter Future Capabilities

- Clear capability growth path agreed for Eurofighter
- Collaborative 4-nation and industry approach
- New capabilities will enhance Eurofighter
- Will remain capable backbone for Air Forces up to 2060 as an international program





Leading the way to FCAS

- During TIMBER EXPRESS two Airbus Remote Carriers were tasked directly by an operational fleet GAF Eurofighter
- Remote Carriers' sensor data exchanged with Eurofighter and other network elements
- Eurofighter and Remote Carriers demonstrated Manned-Unmanned-Teaming elements of the FCAS System-of-Systems approach, providing tactical flexibility
