Juergen Westermeier has been appointed Airbus Chief Procurement Officer (CPO) since 1 September 2020. He is in charge of procurement across Airbus and its divisions, having responsibility for developing strong partnerships with suppliers.

He coordinates strategic procurement topics, as well as the development and application of procurement processes and tools across Airbus.

Juergen is also responsible for the Airbus Regional Procurement Offices in the U.S., India, Singapore and China.

Before joining Airbus, Juergen was President of BMW China Services Ltd. and member of the BMW Group China Board, based in Beijing, China. In this position, he was heading supplier relations and purchasing strategy for the BMW Group in Asia Pacific.

Juergen started his career in 1998 at BMW. He was promoted Head of Information Services in 2002. In 2004, he was appointed Head of Strategy Purchasing Motorcycles followed by a nomination as Head of Purchasing Powertrain Motorcycles in 2007. In 2015, after several managerial positions within Strategy Purchasing, Quality Management and Supplier Network, he became Vice President Cost Engineering. In 2017, Juergen was appointed Senior Vice President Purchasing and Supplier Network in Asia.

Juergen graduated from the University of Karlsruhe where he obtained a degree in Industrial Engineering in 1998.

Born in Freising, Germany in 1972, Juergen is married and enjoys travelling, cycling and discovering new cultures.
