Airbus and Embry-Riddle in Singapore sign MOU on aviation education

Singapore, 13th March 2019 – The AirBusiness Academy and the Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University (ERAU) in Singapore have signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) to collaborate on delivering aviation education and management training programmes for students and talents in the region.
