Siân has a Master's degree in Physics and Astronomy from Durham University in the UK, and started her career at Airbus as part of the UK graduate scheme as a systems engineer. She has since worked at the Portsmouth, Stevenage and Bremen Airbus sites.

Siân's motivation for moving to Bremen was her lifelong fascination with human spaceflight and her ambition to work on the Artemis programme. She is passionate about inspiring the next generation (particularly young women) to pursue careers in STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math) and is an active STEM outreach ambassador.
