Neste MY Sustainable Aviation Fuel[™] (SAF) is a next generation aviation fuel, made from sustainably sourced, 100% renewable waste and residue raw materials, like used cooking oil. Over

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the life cycle and in neat form, Neste's SAF reduces greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions by up to 80% compared to using fossil jet fuel, calculated based on CORSIA LCA-methodology.

Neste currently has an annual production capacity of 100,000 tons (approximately 34 million gallons). By the end of 2023, Neste will have the capacity to produce some 1.5 million tons (515 million gallons) of SAF annually at its refineries in Singapore and Rotterdam. This will increase to 2.2 million tons by 2026 with the expansion of its Rotterdam refinery.
